Learning about Post 16 options and using the Intentions Tool to record their choices
Students in Year 11 all have access to the online careers and progression tool Unifrog which we are trialling. This provides personalised information and guidance on future options whether FE courses or apprenticeships. CVs and personal statements can be drafted here too. The support of teachers and parents is enabled by their access to the service.
