Re: Second-hand textbook sale

As part of ongoing efforts to reduce the School's environmental impact, Environmental Society is pleased to announce that it, in collaboration with the Cultural Committee, will once again be running a second-hand textbook and revision guide sale.

The textbooks being sold will come from within the Olavian community, and we are therefore asking that students bring in any of their own old textbooks which are still in good condition. The procedure for collecting these donations is as follows:

- **For students currently in Y11 and Y13** – we will be collecting textbooks on book return day, on the 10th and 9th June respectively.
- **For students in other years** – a box will be available in each year group's zone into which donations can be deposited after the Half Term break.

These valuable learning materials will then be **available to purchase with cash in the Sixth Form Common Room** at the allotted time on **Monday 21st June**:

- **Y7** – 08:20 - 08:40
- **Y8** – 15:10 - 15:30
- **Y9** – 12:40 - 13:00
- **Y10** – 10:20 - 10:40
- **Y12** – 12:20 - 12:40

For current **Year 11** pupils, books will be available to purchase during the Sixth Form Induction Day on 24th June.

Please be assured that this event will be carried out in an appropriately risk-mitigated way. All books will be quarantined for at least 72 hours before being sold; there will be no mixing of cash as change between year groups; the students selling the textbooks will wear gloves.

All donations of textbooks are hugely appreciated, and proceeds from the sale will be jointly used to support the UK charity Refugee Action and further environmental goals within St. Olave's.
